Creating Spot Glitter Effects CLITTER



Use white ink to make spot glitter accents!

- To incorporate white ink, create a mask (shown here in **black**) wherever you want to **block out** the glitter shine.
- When the design goes to the press, configure this mask to print as white ink. It is critical that this white ink mask prints underneath the CMYK artwork, otherwise the white ink will print overtop of and block out the artwork, not just the glitter.

Why use white ink?

- To highlight certain portions of a design: make text and other graphics pop from the background!
- To ensure fine text legibility, particularly on the seriously sparkling Silver Sheen glitter paper.
- To ensure color-accurate printing in certain areas, like skin tones or product photos, when designing with Silver Sheen or colored glitter.

Diamond Print Glitter™ Design Tip:

Try varying opacity/opacity gradients on your white ink mask to soften the edges of your mask and/or create gradual transitions between glitter & non-glitter areas of your design!
